Some 50 people from the Houston region have joined together to form the Transportation Advocacy Group — Houston Region to seek to secure more funding for transportation in the area despite budget crunches at the state and local level.

“While we are advocates of all modes of transportation, our first efforts are directed to securing additional state funds and local funding authority for the Houston region during the 82nd Legislative Session,” according to a statement attributed to the group’s officers.
